ACAS Update

ACAS AGM —27 October, Meeting and Demonstration by Anna Da Conceicao, Jacksons







Following the official business of our AGM Anna, who has worked at **Jacksons** for 22 years and the last 12 as Manager, gave us an insider's view of her favourite products and a demonstration of her techniques. Having grown up surrounded by flowers with her parent's flower business, Anna uses flowers as her source of inspiration. Generally, Anna works loosely from photos online, embracing any imperfections that are found in nature using the colour, shape, textures, and patterns to create a form of escapism.

Anna chooses archival textured paper – Fabriona Artistico, 300gsm, and starts by roughly mapping out the composition with shapes. She draws with a graphite black matt pencil, either *Mars Lumograph* (blue casing) or *Blackwin*. Step 2 is adding the details with varying pressure. The inks Anna uses is *Daler Rowney FW Acrylic ink* and *Golden Highflow*. They are both vibrant and strong in colour.

Anna starts her painting in a corner with round brushes (D77, 220), only using water to rinse the brush. She has a testing paper and paper towels for blotting. Working quickly, Anna allows the colours to bleed into eachother. The result is spectacular. Beautiful flowers!


