- The design is to be created in a square format of 15 x 15 cm
- Please note- when the logo is viewed on the Instagram page, the square is cropped into a circular shape by Instagram. Consider avoiding including important details in the corners
- The design can be created digitally or physically. If designing digitally, JPEG format is suitable
- The logo will be shrunk into an icon for media such as letter heads and emails, very fine detail may not be suitable
- You may or may not wish to include text

The winner will have their work featured across all ACAS media outputs. Their prize will be a free annual membership.

The ACAS committee will review all designs submitted, and from there decide on the most suitable design.
