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Southwest Scenery Art Tour

with Perth watercolour artist Pam Lockwood

Four days of travel diary painting and sketching in picturesque areas of the south-west of WA with accomplished watercolourist and art tutor, Pam Lockwood.

ITINERARY:

- Day 1 Departing Perth we travel the Forrest Highway to Australind where we enjoy morning tea before continuing to Busselton. We head to the Busselton Jetty for lunch and an afternoon travel diary painting session under Pam's guidance before arriving at our accommodation at the Abbey Beach Resort, home for the next 3 nights. (D)
- Day 2 After a cooked breakfast, we head to Meelup Beach in Dunsborough. The gentle calm water, spacious white sand beach and the big shady park make for a wonderful days' of sketching and painting. Pam will give you hints and tips before you start on your own master piece in this lovely location. Late in the afternoon we return to our accommodation for pre-dinner drinks then dinner. (B,L,D)
- Day 3 Today we take a short drive to Ellensbrook Homestead. The historic homestead at Ellensbrook lies in the national park but is managed by the National Trust. A short walk leads to Meekadarabee ('bathing place of the moon'), a beautiful grotto set below trickling rapids and surrounded by lush bush, so there are plenty of choices to select for your sketching painting. We spend the day here, later returning to our accommodation via Canal Rocks. (B,L,D)
- Day 4 After breakfast we head straight to the beautiful historic town of Bridgetown on the Blackwood River for some last minute travel diary sketching and painting, once again under Pam's guidance. Later we return to Perth via Donnybrook and Pinjarra. (B)
